Garden, June 15-September 15(Fri-Sun)	\$500*
Garden, June 15-September 15(Mon-Thurs)	\$300*
Garden, Rest of Year	\$250*
Pavilion Reception (Fri-Sun)	\$200
Pavilion/Reception (Mon-Thurs)	\$125
Clean up/Damage Deposit	\$250

A fifty percent deposit is due one week after booking inclusive of the refundable clean up/damage deposit\*. The remainder is due four weeks prior to your event. An executed contract will be sent to you shortly after we receive the deposit. Reservations are accepted on a firstcome, first served basis. When booking the garden, you have the use of the garden for the entire day, beginning at 9 a.m. When booking the pavilion for a reception you may use it the entire day, beginning at 9 a.m. The pavilion will be reserved for a two hour timeframe for a rain option during the time of the ceremony, if you should have to use the pavilion due to inclement weather. The Rain Option is included in the standard Garden rental rate.

\*Pavilion/Wedding Garden deposits are non refundable. Clean up/Damage Deposit may be refunded.

Sixteen, eight-foot banquet tables and 125 brown folding chairs are available from the town of Mt. Crested Butte and are included in the garden/pavilion fee. The garden will seat about 125 guests. It measures 53 feet long and 30 feet wide in front of the circle; behind the circle it is 30 feet long and 23 feet wide. The flagstone wedding circle is approximately 20 feet by 20 feet, and the walkway leading into it measures 40 feet by 8 feet wide. There is an outside electrical outlet nearby. The pavilion measures 30 feet long plus 12 feet under the porch (no sides); it is 25.5 feet wide. It is closed on 2 sides, with a white all-weather curtain on one of the open sides. It has 5 glass windows. There are electrical outlets. There are no kitchen facilities on site and there is no changing room provided. If you are hosting a dinner, you will need to rent round tables, linens, china and silverware, bartending station and a dance floor if desired. Bathrooms and limited parking are available. There can be no assurance of the area being free from snow mid-September to mid-June. Snow may be removed with permission from Mt. Crested Butte town officials.
